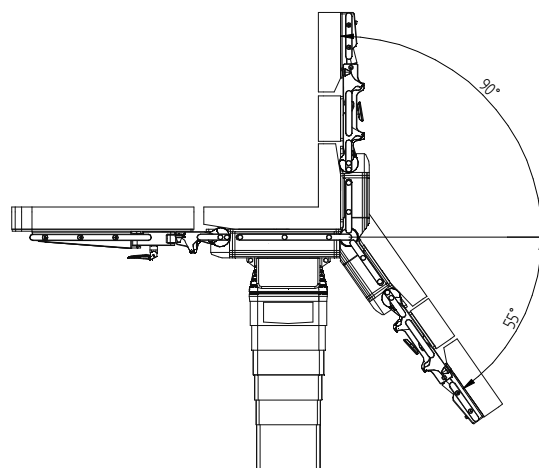

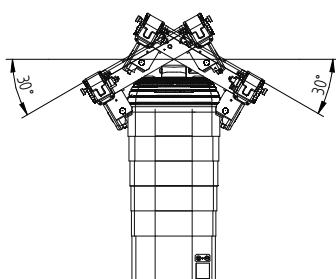
LEG SECTION ADJUSTMENT



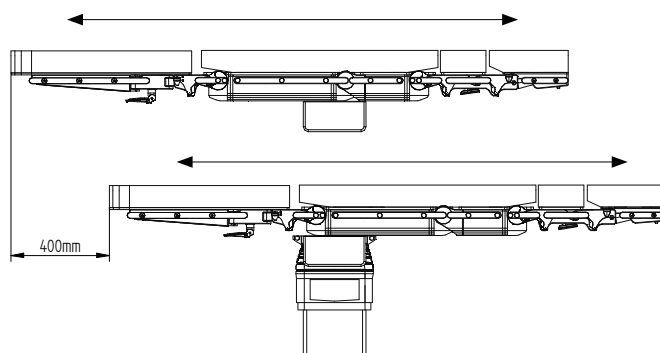
